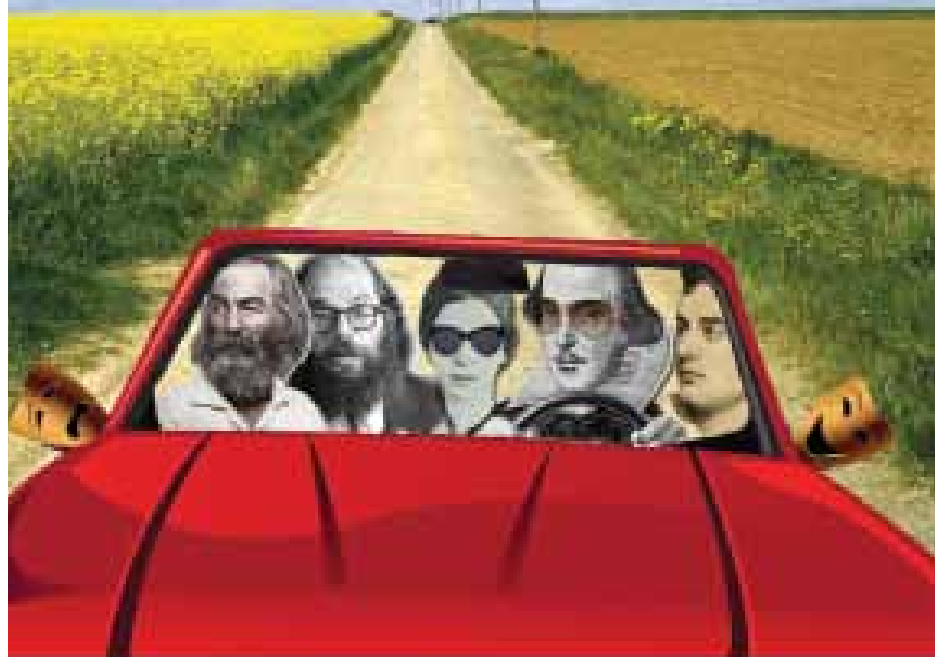

The Authors



Joan Golden (“Prologue”) won the New Mexico Women in Film award for screenwriting last year and has placed in the top three in numerous national contests. She writes screenplays and stage plays and just finished her first children’s book. She studied theater at the University of Colorado.



Leroy Leonard* (“Two by Leroy”) has been acting and writing in Denver since 1978, performing with numerous local theaters. As a playwright, Leroy has worked with Chameleon Stage, the Theater Company of Lafayette, and Coal Creek Community Theater. Since 1987 Leroy has performed and taught as Merry-Andrew Afoot, a one-person children’s theater company.



Ross Peter Nelson (*Cobalt-60*) grew up in Montana, had his first play produced in San Francisco, and earned his M.F.A. in playwriting in New Orleans. Over two dozen of his works have been produced in several states and on three continents. Although he self-identifies as a playwright, he sometimes crosses genres, and has published short fiction in addition to his dramatic work. Ross is a member of the Dramatists Guild.



Bill Thompson* (*POeTry 10¢*) came from a state where there are more cows than people and where 75 percent of the roads are unpaved. He published a book of poetry, *Across the Plains*, in 1978, and once edited a small poetry magazine.

She's a contributor to the Wild Cards series of shared world superhero books edited by George R. R. Martin and a graduate of the Odyssey Fantasy Writing Workshop.
